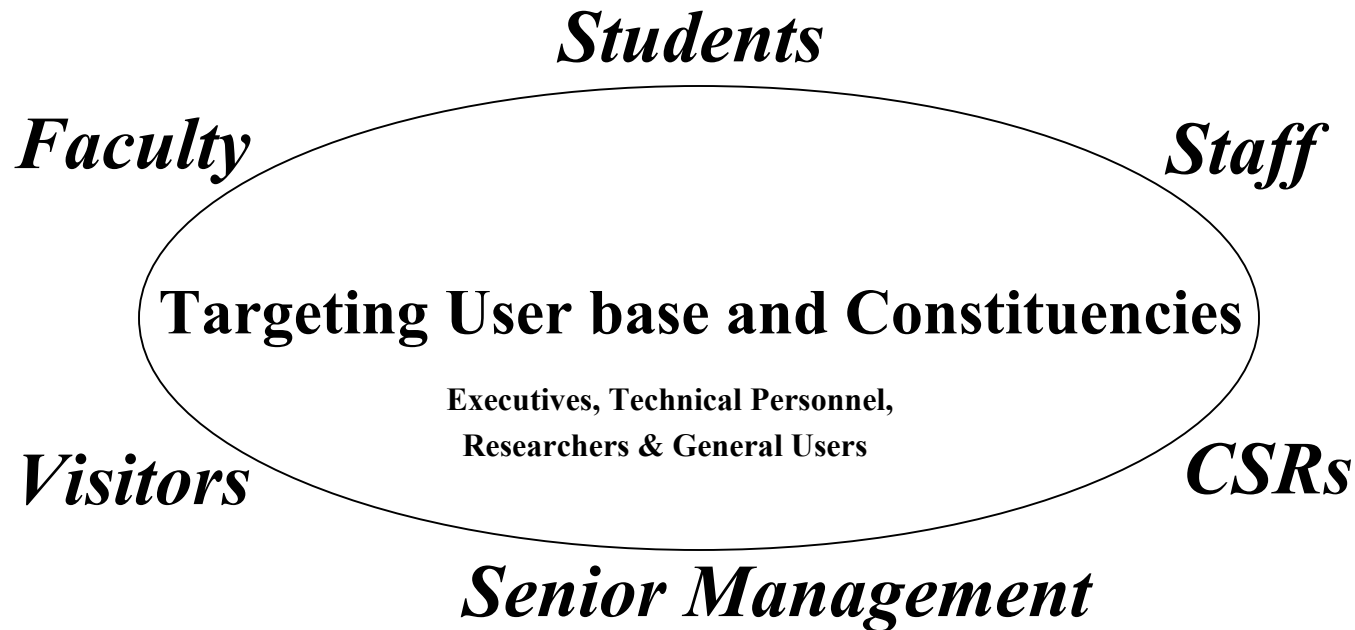


OIT-IS Education and Awareness Program
